Dear Derrick,

Please find attached a Certificate of Substantial Performance (Form 9) for the above noted project. Based on an onsite review completed by GM BluePlan Engineering Limited, it is our opinion that the project satisfied the conditions of Substantial Performance on October 21, 2022 as set out in the Construction Act, R.S.O. 1990, c. C.30, as amended (the Act). As required by Section 32(1) paragraph 5 of the Act, you are now required to publish a copy of the certificate in a manner set out by the regulations.

The Substantial Performance Statutory Holdback Release Payment Certificate shall be due 61 days after the date of publication of the Certificate of Substantial Performance, but subject to the provisions of the Construction Act and your submission of the following documents:

1. A Statutory Declaration form;
2. A satisfactory Certificate of Clearance from the Workplace Safety and Insurance Board;
3. A release by your firm on corporate letterhead in a form satisfactory to the Owner releasing the Owner from all further claims relating to the Contract, qualified by stating exceptions such as outstanding work or matters arising out of subsection GC 3.13 of OPSS.MUNI 100;
4. Proof of publication of the Certificate of Substantial Performance.

Please note that it is your responsibility to provide proof of publication so that we may determine the date of release for the Statutory Holdback.

It should be noted that this 10% holdback includes the work completed as of October 21, 2022. The replacement of the expansion joint seals is not anticipated to be completed in 2022 and therefore, the cost related to this item will not be considered for this holdback release. The Contractor has completed all work intended for 2022 and the project has been considered substantially completed as of the date noted above.
